Treasurers Report – Max. Max is working with the bank to fix an online access problem with the accounts. **See “June 2020 Treasure’s Report”.** Highlight: \$5600 in assessments were collected in May and June.

Approve May Minutes: Mary motioned to approve May’s Minutes, Max seconded the motion.

Current:

- **Bylaws** – final adjustments made. Bylaws are going to be sent to Jake (lawyer) for a final review and then will be sent to the membership for the final 30 day review.
- **Road Maintenance Update** – Mitch added 9 loads of material to the north end of Crawford road, recrowned and mitigating water runoff in the area.
- **Annual Meeting in August:** depending on the state of the pandemic we will be aiming to hold a meeting in August. If it is still unsafe to do so then we will aim to hold it virtually. A Sunday may be the day it will be held on.
- **Fund Raisers:** More money is needed to continue to improve the road as well as support community projects.

Ideas:

- Auction for naming rights on trail(s), benches, bridges, etc.
- Fun Run w/ Crawford “Goody bag”
- Annual Crawford Community Event that can include vendors, garage sales, t-shirt sales, raffle, etc.

Will likely start small and build as we would like to start getting funds from the general public since they use the road too.

- **Hump teams –**
 - Memo created for team guidelines.
 - Craig agreed to move blocks to the ends of the humps.
 - Advanced notice to the public will be needed before the event (signs on roadway)
 - About a week before the event the humps and blocks should be washed.
 - Make the repainting an Annual event. (This will affect paint choice.) Agreed that there is no need to buy expensive paint and expect it to fade and need redone.
 - Benefits of Annual Event – we can combine with community volunteer day - cleaning trash, trail upkeep and edging weeds etc. After the work is done having a progressive BBQ to meet your neighborhood.
 - Bird houses all along the trail – maybe have a contest? – best birdhouse.
 - Bench building for benches along the trail.

- **Trail**
 - Chris is taking on the trail near his property
 - Craig will put in half of the cost of materials and provide the labor for the trail from his property to Forest Lane. This means a cost of approximately \$1000 - \$1500 from MCRA to help cover material costs.
